## Parking and Road Safety:

School drop-off and collections are extremely busy traffic times daily and we need to be ever-vigilant of the risks on the road in front of the school. I acknowledge the lack/shortage of parking space for all however I would like to ask you to please note the following:

- The yellow box at the school entrance must be kept clear at all times this is not a drop off or 'set down' area.
