## Dear parents,

I hope you all had a relaxing and enjoyable weekend. Below are some points of information for your reference:

- 1. *Support Teaching:* Our Support Teaching timetable has commenced after much planning and organisation. Support teaching in schools can take on many different forms whereby pupils' needs are supported through a variety of approaches and methodologies e.g. Team Teaching, group work and one to one teaching. Throughout the school year, all pupils may be involved in such approaches thus promoting inclusion and integration of all pupils and their diverse needs in our school. Our support team this term consist of: Ms L O Sullivan, Ms A Cronin, Ms K Parker & Mr O Daly. Our special class teacher is Ms M Cronin.
- **2.** *GAA Skills:* Mr. Cooper will return on Mondays to work with all pupils from Junior Infants to Sixth Class. This will continue every second Monday for the school year as part of our PE policy. We look forward to seeing our school team line out as part of Cumann na mBunscol competition in the coming weeks!
- **3.** *Irish Sign Language:* We look forward to welcoming John Patrick Doherty back on 19<sup>th</sup> September to work with the pupils. This is part of the 'Say Yes to Languages' programme and runs in conjunction with our Class for Pupils who are Deaf/ Hard of Hearing. We look forward to celebrating *International Week of Deaf People* from Monday, 23<sup>rd</sup> September. (see ISL Alphabet below).
- **4.** Creative Communities Art Project: We have been chosen to partake in two art workshops as part of an initiative funded by Creative Ireland and Kerry Co. Council Art Office.
